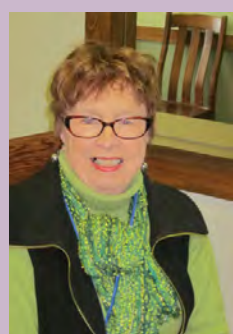

Klinefelter comes to the PCC with a vast array of qualifications. Born in Pennsylvania and raised in the suburbs of Baltimore and Washington D.C., Phil moved to the West Salem area in 1972. In 1983 Phil's self-admitted path of destruction led him to a place where God

could finally get his attention. Since the early 90's he has ministered throughout the Ohio State prison system in partnership with John Schmid of Common Ground Ministries. He has also led a monthly church service within the Wayne County jail system since 1983 and was appointed assistant chaplain in February of 2012 to present.

Phil is married to Betty, and they are the proud parents of five wonderful children. The Klinefelters attend Pleasant Hill Baptist Church in Smithville, where Phil serves as deacon. He states that he looks forward to the PCC position and serving our community in another chapter of his life.

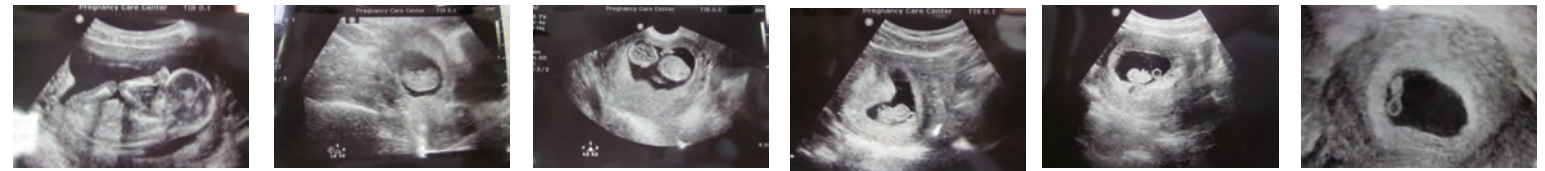
..and Healing to Those Who Have Experienced the Loss of an Infant

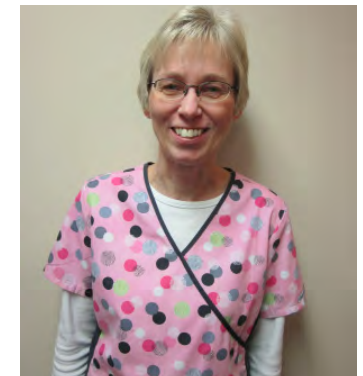


**Elaine Spademan, PCC's Newest

Meet PCC's 2014/2015 school year's teaching staff for the Healthy Choices for Healthy Teens Programs! By the end of May 2015, this staff will have presented abstinence from drugs, alcohol, sex, and tobacco in every school district in Wayne and Holmes counties. Approximately 3400 students will have been reached with this message which is geared for middle and high school classes.

The students were asked: "What is something you learned from the RSVP program?"

What I learned:

"STDs spread through any sexual contact"

"Drugs are terrible"

"Why it is smart to stay abstinent and what effects it could have on your life"

"How to know if you're in a healthy relationship"

On May 6, 2014, Hui Liu began Earn While You Learn (EWYL) parenting classes at the PCC. Her counselor/client advocate was Carol Rood and together they anticipated the birth of Henry Sagn Liu on June 28, 2014.

I asked Carol how she feels about Hui. She said, "I love her!" Every week Hui would come to the Pregnancy Center and tell Carol how thankful she was to have the PCC and a friend like Carol. Hui was not in so much need of material items, such as diapers and infant clothing.

However, she was delighted to receive the friendship and the child development classes. Carol and Hui have many memories of "translation barriers" such as, "What is patty cake?" (So then Carol did a demonstration!) Carol did a great job of teaching Hui American slang. "Hui was one of the most grateful clients I have ever served," said Carol. "She

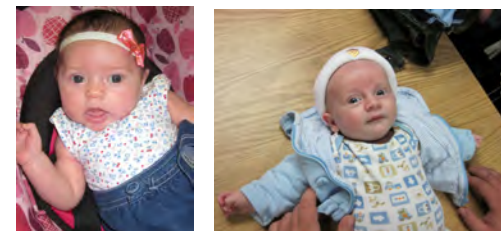
