

### Volunteer Highlight




Mary currently serves in the Healthy Choices for Healthy Teens program as a Peer Speaker. She shares her testimony in

## WOW! HAVE THESE TWINS GROWN FAST!







# Development Reflections

Many of our founding fathers gave of their personal wealth to win freedom and the greatest system of government known to man. One example, Signer of the Declaration of Independence Robert Morris issued \$1,000,000 in credit for the revolutionary war effort and raised \$200,000 from friends to defeat the British. He was never reimbursed by his country but helped change the world. Other founders, who believed in God and their duty to "...let your good works be seen before men so that they will glorify your Father...", started educational institutions, bible societies, aide societies and other associations to make a difference in their new country; they did not wait for or expect the government to do what they could do themselves.



In the tradition of our forefathers, the people of the United States have continued taking responsibility for service to our nation by their generous charitable giving; the Charity Aide Foundation has ranked the United States the most charitable country in the world.




### Opportunity to Serve!
