One of the greatest blessings in serving at the PCC is having the privilege of seeing a baby placed into the arms of adoptive parents. And in this infant's case, seeing the birth mom as the individual making this transition. This little one's mom has been quick to share the following testimony:

"When I came to the Pregnancy Center, I had considered abortion as an option. After meeting with the staff at the PCC and understanding all my options I decided to create an adoption plan for my baby. And I choose to hand my baby to its adoptive mom and dad. A very happy time for them, yet sad for me. but I know I have made the right choice for my baby."

Our staff and volunteers will continue to reach out to this mom with post-adoption peer counseling and support.



The "gift" of a baby shower for one of our moms!


We are so thankful to Cross View Church of Orrville for hosting a baby shower for this "mom to be".

Women of Hope jail ministry gives moms a new start




Women in jail face an uncertain future, especially if they are pregnant or already have children. But women in the Wayne County Jail have a resource that gives them tools to make a brighter future.

Two years ago, Jeanne Altland started helping with a ministry serving women in the jail. The chaplain at the jail at that time had arranged for the ministry to start, and Altland, a retired child welfare social worker, stayed on and took over its leadership after he left about two months later.

"I really like meeting with these ladies," she said. Altland is also the assistant office manager at Pregnancy Care Center (PCC) of Wayne County in Wooster, OH. "I think we're providing something they like."
